

Make delish snow cones in minutes with this super speedy, seriously cool Snow Cone Maker – yuuuummy! Remember though, read all of the instructions carefully and keep them for future reference.

### **SAFE & SOUND**

When you're using the Snow Cone Maker you gotta keep safe and sound, so make sure that when you use electrical gadgets you always stick to these basic safety precautions.

### **SAFETY INFO**

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed.

Check that the voltage indicated on the rating plate corresponds with that of the local network before connecting the appliance to the mains power supply. Children aged from 8 years and people with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge can use this appliance, only if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Children should be supervised to ensure that they don't play with the appliance. Unless they are older than 8 and supervised, children should not perform cleaning or user maintenance.

This appliance is not a toy.

This appliance contains no user serviceable parts. If the power supply cord, plug or any part of the appliance is malfunctioning, or if the appliance has been dropped or damaged, only a qualified electrician should carry out repairs. Improper repairs may place the user at risk of harm.

Keep the appliance and its power supply cord out of reach of children. Keep the appliance and its power supply cord away from heat or sharp edges that could cause damage.

Keep the appliance away from heat emitting appliances.



Keep hands, fingers, hair and any loose clothing away from the rotating tools of the appliance.

Don't touch any moving parts on this appliance during use, as this could cause injury.

Don't immerse the appliance in water or any other liquid.

Don't operate the appliance with wet hands.

Don't use broken or loose cutting or rotating blades.

Don't overload the appliance; only fill up to the maximum level marked on the appliance as the mixture level may rise during use.

Don't leave the appliance unattended whilst connected to the mains power supply. Don't remove the appliance from the mains power supply by pulling the cord; switch it off and remove the plug by hand.

Don't use the appliance for anything other than its intended use.

Don't use any accessories other than those supplied.

Don't use this appliance outdoors.

Don't store the appliance in direct sunlight or in high humidity conditions.

Don't move the appliance whilst it is in use.

Don't place boiling water or very hot liquid in the appliance.

Always unplug the appliance after use and before any cleaning or user maintenance.

Always use the appliance on a stable, heat-resistant surface, at a height that is comfortable for the user.

Use of an extension cord with the appliance is not recommended.

This appliance should not be operated by means of an external timer or separate remote control system, other than that supplied with this appliance.

This appliance is intended for domestic use only. It should not be used for commercial purposes.

Warning: Don't touch sharp blades.

Remove your Snow Cone Maker from the box.

Remove any packaging from the Snow Cone Maker.

Place the packaging inside the box and either store or dispose of safely.

### **GET READY...**

# **IT'S PARTY TIME!**

Before using your seriously cool Snow Cone Maker for the first time, you should wipe it down with a soft, damp cloth and let it dry thoroughly. Make sure that you clean all of the bits too!

Remember, don't immerse your Snow Cone Maker in water or any other liquid! **Note:** When using your Snow Cone Maker for the first time, it may emit a slight odour. This is nothing to worry about and will soon go away, as long as you make sure that your Snow Cone Maker is getting enough ventilation.



### GET SET...

# **ASSEMBLING YOUR SERIOUSLY COOL SNOW CONE MAKER**

Carefully pull your Snow Cone Maker base unit and power unit away from each other to separate them.

Position your Snow Cone Maker base unit on a stable, heat-resistant surface at a height that is comfortable for you to let it go and let it snow.

Insert the Snow Cone Maker power unit into the slot at the top of the Snow Cone Maker base unit, and then carefully push it down until the two sections are joined together.

Attach the ice shaving chamber by lowering it into the ice shaving chamber cradle, making sure that you press it down gently until it is nice and secure.

## GO!

### **MAKING DELISH SNOW CONES**

Fill the ice shaving chamber with fully frozen ice cubes, making sure that you don't go past the Max. fill mark as things could get messy and your seriously cool Snow Cone Maker could get damaged!

Place a paper cone into the snow cone cradle.

Plug in and switch on your Snow Cone Maker at the mains power supply.

Lock the lid into position by placing it onto the ice shaving chamber and then twisting it in an anticlockwise direction; this will set your Snow Cone Maker in motion.

It's snow time! Let your Snow Cone Maker do its thaaaaaaang until your delish snow cones are ready to go!

Once your paper cone is brimming with snow, twist the lid in a clockwise direction to stop the Snow Cone Maker. Switch your full paper cone for an empty one and then restart your seriously cool Snow Cone Maker. Repeat until you've got the required number of snow cones or until the ice runs out.

Add your fave juice or drink for a truly super flavoursome snow cone!

**Note:** Make sure that the lid is securely attached to the ice shaving chamber before use.



**Tip!** If you're making more than one snow cone, make sure that you've got plenty of bowls or suitable holders ready for when you switch your full paper cones for empty ones.

**Caution:** Don't fill the ice shaving chamber past the Max. fill mark, as things could get messy and could damage your seriously cool Snow Cone Maker — boohoo! **Warning:** Don't try to remove the ice shaving chamber too soon — make sure that the Snow Cone Maker power unit has stopped running and remove the lid first. **Warning:** Maximum operation time is 2 minutes. Allow the Snow Cone Maker power unit to cool for 2 minutes before using again.

### DISASSEMBLING YOUR SERIOUSLY COOL SNOW CONE MAKER

Twist the lid in a clockwise direction to remove it and stop your Snow Cone Maker. Once the Snow Cone Maker power unit has completely stopped, carefully remove the ice shaving chamber from the ice shaving chamber cradle. Inside the ice shaving chamber you will find a spinning container which can also be dismantled for cleaning. To do so, remove the central plug by twisting it in an anticlockwise direction and then pull it out; you can now access and remove the spinning container.

Take care when removing the spinning container as it has integrated sharp blades and you could hurt yourself.

When you've cleaned up, reinsert the spinning container into the ice shaving chamber, then replace the central plug and twist it in a clockwise direction to secure it.

To assemble your Snow Cone Maker again, follow the instructions in the section entitled 'Assembling Your Seriously Cool Snow Cone Maker'.

# **KEEPING YOUR SNOW CONE MAKER IN APPLE PIE ORDER!**

Before attempting any cleaning or maintenance, unplug your Snow Cone Maker from the mains power supply.

Clean the Snow Cone Maker power unit with a soft, damp cloth and dry thoroughly. Remember, don't immerse the Snow Cone Maker power unit in water or any other liquid!



You can wash the Snow Cone Maker base unit, snow cone cradle, lid and ice shaving chamber in warm, soapy water but make sure you dry them properly! Never use harsh or abrasive cleaning detergents or scourers to clean your Snow Cone Mixer as this could cause damage.

Your Snow Cone Mixer should be cleaned after every use to keep it in tiptop condition.

Warning: The ice shaving chamber contains a sharp blade; handle it carefully when cleaning. To access and clean the blade, disassemble the spinning container following the instructions in the section entitled 'Disassembling Your Seriously Cool Snow Cone Maker' and then carefully clean the blade with a brush.

### STORING YOUR SNOW CONE MAKER AWAY

Before storing, ensure that your Snow Cone Maker is cool, clean and dry. Never store whilst it is wet.

Never wrap the cord tightly around your Snow Cone Maker; wrap it loosely to avoid causing damage.

Store in a cool, dry place.

# TROPICAL FRUIT CONES INGREDIENTS

Ice cubes
2 mangoes, chopped
250 grams pineapple, chopped
1 Lime, juiced
Lime wedges, to garnish

### **METHOD**

Put the chopped mangoes, pineapple and lime juice into a food processor, then blend until liquified.

Fill the ice shaving chamber with fully frozen ice, making sure that you don't go past the Max. fill mark.

Place a paper cone into the snow cone cradle and then switch on your Snow Cone Maker.

Collect the 'snow' in the paper cones.

Once your paper cone is brimming with snow, pour over the prepared tropical juice.

Add a wedge of lime, to garnish.



# APPLE AND GRAPE FRUIT CONES INGREDIENTS

Ice cubes
300 grams caster sugar
350 millilitres water
225 millilitres apple juice or cider
115 millilitres red grape juice
Juice of 1 lime

### **METHOD**

Add the caster sugar and water to a pan and bring it to the boil over a high heat, stirring often until the sugar is dissolved. Pour the liquid into a bowl and allow to cool to room temperature before refrigerating.

Once cool, add the apple, grape and lime juice, then refrigerate once more for approximately 2 hours or until suitably chilled.

Fill the ice shaving chamber with fully frozen ice, making sure that you don't go past the Max. fill mark.

Place a paper cone into the snow cone cradle and then switch on your Snow Cone Maker.

Collect the 'snow' in the paper cones.

Once your paper cone is brimming with snow, pour over the prepared apple and grape syrup.



# **BLUEBERRY MOJITO CONES**

### INGREDIENTS

Ice cubes

50 grams blueberries

50 grams caster sugar

85 millilitres white rum

60 millilitres water

7–8 fresh mint leaves

Juice of 1 lime

Mint sprig, to garnish

### METHOD

Add the blueberries, caster sugar, water and mint leaves to a pan and bring it to the boil over a medium heat, stirring continuously to mash the blueberries and bruise the mint leaves. Pour the liquid into a bowl and allow to cool for approximately 10 minutes.

Once cool, strain the syrup to remove the blueberry skins and mint leaves, then add the white rum and lime juice.

Fill the ice shaving chamber with fully frozen ice, making sure that you don't go past the Max. fill mark.

Place a paper cone into the snow cone cradle and then switch on your Snow Cone Maker

Collect the 'snow' in the paper cones.

Once your paper cone is brimming with snow, pour over the prepared blueberry mojito syrup.

Add a sprig of mint, to garnish.



# PIÑA COLADA CONES INGREDIENTS

Ice cubes
1 pineapple, peeled, cored and diced
200 grams caster sugar
70 grams shredded coconut
250 millilitres water
125 millilitres unsweetened coconut milk

### **METHOD**

Add the caster sugar and water to a pan and bring it to the boil over a medium heat, stirring often until the sugar is dissolved. Pour the liquid into a bowl and allow to cool to room temperature.

Put the cooled syrup, coconut milk and  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the pineapple into a blender, then blend until smooth.

Fill the ice shaving chamber with fully frozen ice, making sure that you don't go past the Max. fill mark.

Place a paper cone into the snow cone cradle and then switch on your Snow Cone Maker.

Collect the 'snow' in the paper cones.

Once your paper cone is brimming with snow, pour over the prepared piña colada syrup.

Add the remaining pineapple, to garnish.



# **MOCHA CONES**

### **INGREDIENTS**

Ice cubes
400 grams caster sugar
65 grams cocoa powder
250 millilitres water
3 tablespoons instant coffee granules
Shaved chocolate, to garnish

### **METHOD**

Add the caster sugar, cocoa powder, instant coffee granules and water to a pan and bring it to the boil over a medium heat, stirring often until the sugar and coffee are dissolved. Strain the mixture, then pour it into a bowl and refrigerate until suitably chilled.

Fill the ice shaving chamber with fully frozen ice, making sure that you don't go past the Max. fill mark.

Place a paper cone into the snow cone cradle and then switch on your Snow Cone Maker

Collect the 'snow' in the paper cones.

Once your paper cone is brimming with snow, pour over the prepared mocha syrup.

Add some shaved chocolate, to garnish.



#### **CONNECTION TO THE MAINS**

Please check that the voltage indicated on the product corresponds with your supply voltage.

### **IMPORTANT**

As the colours in the mains lead of this appliance may not correspond with the coloured markings identifying the terminals in your plug, please proceed as follows:

The wires in the mains lead are coloured in accordance with the following code:

Blue Neutral (N)

Brown Live (L)

FOR UK USE ONLY - Plug fitting details (where applicable).



The wire coloured BROWN is the LIVE wire and must be connected to the terminal marked L or coloured RED.

On no account must either the BROWN or the BLUE wire be connected to the EARTH terminal  $\frac{1}{2}$ ).

Always ensure that the cord grip is fastened correctly.


The plug must be fitted with a fuse off the same rating already fitted and conforming to BS1362 and be ASTA approved.

If in doubt consult a qualified electrician who will be pleased to do this for you.

# **NON-REWIREABLE MAINS PLUG**

If your appliance is supplied with a non-rewireable plug fitted to the mains lead and should the fuse need replacing, you must use an ASTA approved one (conforming to BS1362 of the same rating).

If in doubt, consult a qualified electrician who will be pleased to do this for you. If you need to remove the plug - DISCONNECT IT FROM THE MAINS and then cut it off the mains lead and immediately dispose of it safely. Never attempt to reuse the plug or insert it into a socket outlet as there is a danger of an electric shock.
